Topic for F1 Classes: Marvellous Me – My favourite things and meeting Rosie the Guinea Pig

<p>Working together, sharing, turn taking, developing an awareness of their own needs and feelings and those of others, trying new activities and developing their concentration skills.</p> <p>Working on initiating conversations and forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults in the class setting.</p>	<p>Children to bring in a photograph of their favourite person or pet and share the reason why with the class.</p> <p>Children to listen to others one to one or in small groups.</p> <p>Children to listen to stories with increasing attention and recall.</p> <p>Phase One – Sound discrimination activities and games.</p>	<p>Children to practise writing their names by copying some letters.</p> <p>To hold a pencil between thumb and two fingers, no longer using whole-hand grasp.</p> <p>Dancing to our favourite songs.</p> <p>Bikes, scooters and the climbing frame.</p> <p>Baking a small cake.</p>	<p>Children to join in with number rhymes and songs.</p> <p>Playing number related board games.</p> <p>Working on basic 2D shapes and their properties i.e. a triangle has three sides.</p> <p>Basic 2D shapes we will be working with are: triangle, square, circle and rectangle.</p> <p>Showing an interest in shapes and making arrangements with them.</p>	<p>To talk about significant events in their own lives e.g. What they did at the weekend or before/after nursery?</p> <p>We will be discussing how we look after our pets.</p> <p>Introducing Rosie the Guinea Pig. As a class we will talk about how we can care and look after her.</p>	<p>Singing a variety of songs including ones about Autumn.</p> <p>Using various construction i.e. wooden bricks. Children to begin stacking blocks vertically and horizontally, making enclosures and creating spaces.</p>
